At the moment we are preparing for the memorial service for the late Mrs Violet Tshingwana which will be on 15 July 2017 at Gwelutshena. We are planning a big service and all churches under St Johns Gwelutshena will be there as she was the leader of the Mothers Union.

We might have some problems in feeding all the people in attendance but we hope with all we have raised so far it will all go well.
